Milliner Celine Cavé, who has designed three of the Prix de Diane Longines winning creations in recent years, tells us the secrets of the French Elegance.



IT IS NOT THE SIZE OF THE HAT THAT MAKES THE STYLE !

The chosen hat should reflect the personality of the lady who wears it. Hats that sit back and leave the face free (more prominent with glasses or even a masque) rather than those that are "overshadow" the face are the trend.



PLAY WITH COLOURS

In France it is considered in bad taste to wear the same-coloured hat and dress. Dare to wear a hat of a different colour by respecting this simple rule: find the right balance. For example, if you were a dress with a big print, chose a more refined hat, and if you wear a block colour dress, then your hat should only reflect that same colour with the slimmest of trims.

WHAT KIND OF HAT Makes you look more svelte?

If you want to appear taller, chose a big hat in terms of height rather than circumference. It should be placed at an angle, which will give the outfit some movement. With a short and fitted dress, that interrupts the silhouette, don't ruin the look by wearing a cape!

HAVE FUN WITH IT!

A hat will only be noticed when the lady who sports it is happy to wear it and shines in her outfit

TAKE A STEP BACK!

If you want to make sure that you are wearing the right hat with the right outfit, take a photo from about 20 metres away and look at the result. That is what the jury of the Miss Diane by Longines competition of elegance will see on the horseshoe-shaped catwalk.

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PRIX DE DIANE LONGINES A GREAT RACE PACKED WITH RACING HISTORY!

Since 1843 the best fillies have come together to compete in the Prix de Diane Longines, which unfolds against the enchanting backdrop of the Chateau de Chantilly and the magnificent stables of the Princes de Condés. Each year in June this great race, open to three-year-old fillies, is one of the most important events in the European Flat racing calendar. It anoints the best filly and ensures that her prestigious bloodline will enjoy an exceptional career at stud.



These equine champions that combine the qualities required to make the line-up of this race are what owners dream about all over the world.

Of the 8 races on this great day of sport, which starts at 2.00 pm, the Prix de Diane Longines offers the highest prize-money. It is worth 1 Million Euros, of which 571 400 Euros goes to the winning connections. Following a magnificent parade on the track, the start of this race is scheduled for 4.15 pm.



Fict you know?

GROUP 1, THE HIGHEST STANDARD IN THE SPORT

The Prix de Diane Longines is a Group 1 race, the highest standard of Flat-racing in the International Calendar. These races are open to horses that have shown an exceptional aptitude that allows them to exceed speeds of 65km/h!

KEY FIGURES OF THE PRIX DE DIANE LONGINES



With amazing hats will parade on the podium in the hope of winning the Competition of Elegance Miss Diane by Longines.

> 2000 hatboxes

That are collectible items and contain a lunch created by chef Justine Piluso will be opened during the year's most stylish picnic on the lawns of the Chantilly racecourse.



Will broadcast the Prix de Diane Longines live and will also offer betting opportunities.



The record time for this race that is run over 2100m is 2'03"77. The record belongs to the champion Trêve, who won the 2013 renewal of the Prix de Diane with an average speed of 61km/h.



The most successful silks in the Prix de Diane Longines are those of HH Aga Khan: Shemaka (1993), Vereva (1997), Zainta (1998), Daryaba (1999), Zarkava (2008), Sarafina (2010) and Valyra (2012).



Only two fillies have won the Prix de Diane and the Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, the best race in the world: Trêve and Zarkava.

5 VICTORIES

Four jockeys have won this race five times. Gerald Mossé is the most successful active jockey to have won this race 5 times between 1988 and 1999.



Have trained the winner of the Diane: Christiane Head: Harbour (1982), Egyptband (2000), Trêve (2013) Corinne Barande-Barbe: Carling (1995)

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Over the past 30 years, fillies trained in France have won the Prix de Diane 24 times comparted to their English rivals (4 victories) and Irish rivals (2 victories)!

CHANTILLY WHERE THE HORSE IS KING



The greatest fillies' race has always been held in the cradle of racing. It all started in Chantilly! In 1833, Prince Lobanoff and Messrs de Normandie, d'Hédouville, de Wagram and de Plaisance saddled up to go hunting. On their way, they came across a vast area in front of the Château de Chantilly and its Great Stables. Remarking on the pleasant underfoot conditions, they engaged in a friendly race, which was won by Mr de Normandie, the future president of the Jockey Club.

The men had been seduced by English racing and were looking in vain for the ideal site to build a racecourse capable of competing with those in England. Mr de Normandie succeeded in obtaining the support of the Duc d'Orléans – one of Louis-Philippe's sons and also a racing enthusiast – and they agreed to organise a race meeting the following spring. It was the launch of Chantilly racecourse and its unique setting!

Not far from the racecourse, the forest of Chantilly is home to the largest training centre dedicated to the training of racehorses. Every morning, more than 2200 horses conditioned by 110 trainers venture out onto the France Galop managed tracks. This is where champions prepare for their next race.

FRANCE GALOP ORGANISER OF THE PRIX DE DIANE LONGINES

FRANCE GALOP

The Prix de Diane Longines is a France Galop event. The association's mission is to organise and control the racing sector in France. It promotes the breeding and training of racehorses by paying out prize-money in Flat and Jump races, and premiums to breeders and owners of racehorses. Within this framework, France Galop plays an important role in the organisation of more than 7 000 Flat and Jump races that are staged on 142 racecourses in France each year.

France Galop also oversees the integrity of races, whether it is ensuring the rules of racing are applied or to test horses for prohibited substances (there is a zero-tolerance policy in place and 100% of winners are tested). France Galop is responsible for five racecourses (Chantilly, Auteuil, ParisLongchamp, Deauville and Saint-Cloud) and three training centres dedicated to training racehorses. (Deauville, Chantilly and Maisons-Laffitte).



M6 AND PARIS PREMIÈRE BROADCASTER OF THE PRIX DE DIANE LONGINES

As in the past two years, M6 will again provide a free and live broadcast of the Prix de Diane Longines. The show is fronted by Carine Galli and Guillaume Coves who will open the doors to Chantilly and this prestigious event to their viewers to share the highlights of the day. The event is also broadcast on Paris Premiere.
