For more than 100 years, racing enthusiasts from around the globe have gathered at ParisLongchamp on the first weekend in October for the Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, the world's most legendary horse race. The world's best thoroughbreds, ridden by the best international jockeys, compete against each other in a race laced with excitement and emotions.

BROADCAST IN 60 COUNTRIES: A GLOBAL EVENT

The world's greatest race is broadcast in more than 60 countries and attracts more than 35,000 spectators into the grandstand of ParisLongchamp racecourse. It is also a fascinating betting contest. More than 93M Euros was wagered across the world last year, a new record for a race day.

QATAR PRIX DE L'ARC DE TRIOMPHE: THE RICHEST RACE IN FRANCE

Adjudged to have been the best racehorse in the world on several occasions, it is also the richest race in the French racing programme. The Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe is worth 5M Euros, which is distributed among the first five finishers.




